2. The Rec	cipient agrees that the named horse will resi	de at:

- 4. The horse may never be raced or bred, assigned or disposed of. Should a life-threatening situation arise, Prancing Horse must immediately be made aware of the circumstances, and named horse may only be humanely euthanized by a licensed veterinarian.
- 5. The named horse may never be sold, adopted, transferred, auctioned, released, given away, or otherwise placed into the possession of another individual or organization by the subject Recipient/Adopter without advising Prancing Horse. Should the subject Adopter decide to rehome the equine, the

Recipient/Adopter must furnish Prancing Horse with the name, address, and telephone number of any potential adoptive individual or organization, and Prancing Horse must grant approval of any prospective individual or organization intending to take possession of the equine prior to it being transferred. The future adopter will be required to complete and sign a copy of the Prancing Horse Adoption and Rehoming Policy.

If the Recipient/Adopter no longer wishes to or cannot care for the named equine, it must be transferred back to Prancing Horse Farm. A (sixty) day notice must be given and a \$500 donation is to be paid to Prancing Horse. This fee goes towards the expense Prancing Horse will incur in providing care for the named horse until a new placement can be found. This fee and notice may be waived for extenuating financial or personal health situations when it is in the best interest of the horse.

- 6. Any horse being returned to Prancing Horse Center will require a current negative Coggins, all of its shots must be up to date to include Rhino Flu, Tetanus, Eastern Western Encephalitis, Coggins, West Nile, Rabies, Strangles, which are the responsibility of the current adoptive owner identified in this policy.
- 7. The Adopter agrees in advance that Prancing Horse Center has the right to obtain all veterinary records directly from any veterinarian treating the horse named in this Policy.
- 8. The Adopter agrees to permit a representative of Prancing Horse Center to inspect the stabling and care of the named horse. If the situation is undesirable for the well-being of the named horse according to the standards explained above, the named horse will be transferred back to Prancing Horse Center.
- 9. The Adopter releases Prancing Horse Center from any liability and agrees to hold harmless Prancing Horse Center and any of its employees, agents, directors, or trustees from any and all liability related to the horse, and any injury or cause of action related to the horse. Prancing Horse Center makes no representations or guarantees about the soundness, abilities, temperament or health of the horse from the time said horse is released to the adoptive Recipient(s) identified in this Policy. Furthermore, the Adopter agrees to all conditions set forth in this Policy regarding the above aforementioned.
