For the first year of adoption, the Adopter agrees to supply (by message or email) at the 6th & 12th month photographs of the Horse in daylight setting where the Horse's body and hooves can be seen in full view without obstruction. At this time, please advise us of any health or conduct issues you may be having with the Horse for us to assist you via phone call or farm visit. Adopter agrees in advance that BTRE can collaborate with your veterinarian and discuss said horse to provide support should any issues arise, and that execution of this Contract shall serve as a release to the applicable veterinarian. Adopter acknowledges that BTRE has authority to investigate any reports of alleged abuse or neglect of horse by Adopter at any time. BTRE may request photos, videos, vet reports and in-person visits to the horse's current location by BTRE staff or its appointed representative. BTRE would appoint a licensed equine veterinarian/equine professional to participate in the investigation by examining the subject horse. Should that veterinarian/equine professional/BTRE Representative conclude a horse is being neglected or abused, the adopter may request to have a second party veterinarian/equine

professional render an opinion. Should the second veterinarian/equine professional differ from the first opinion, the two veterinarians/equine professionals shall appoint a third veterinarian. The opinion of the third-party veterinarian/equine professional would be binding on the adopter and BTRE. The adopter shall relinquish their rights to the horse, the said horse will be removed from that location and transported back to BTRE for readmission to the adoption program (repossession). Adopter agrees that no court order shall be required for BTRE to Repossess a horse and Adopter agrees to cooperate with BTRE and/or its agents during the Repossession process. Adopter further agrees that, upon possession of the Adopted Horse being taken by BTRE or its agents during Repossession, all right, title and interest in the Adopted Horse shall thereupon transfer from Adopter to BTRE. Adopter accepts the conditions set forth in this Contract and hereby releases and forever discharges BTRE, Inc. and its employees, Board Members, successors, subsidiaries and assigns from all claims, demands, obligations, liabilities, or damages in any way arising out of or related to Repossession of the Adopted Horse.

Re-homing Practices: BTRE understands that not all adoptions may be successful through no fault of the adopter or horse. If you find that you may not be able to keep the horse, please contact BTRE as soon as possible so we can discuss options. We always welcome back any equines that are adopted from us. Adopter acknowledges Horse cannot be sold, given away, disposed of and is the responsibility of Adopter for at least 1-year from date of this contract. The Adopter agrees to notify BTREat such time if they are selling or rehoming the Adopted Horse. The Adopter agrees to employ the same best practices new owner references, facility verification, strict no racing, no breeding, no auction, no slaughter stipulations, previously described in this contract on the care and re-homing/adoption of this Horse and must notify BTRE of horse's new home within 10-days of horse being placed. "First Right of Refusal" applies to this new owner also, if said Horse is ever discovered to be in jeopardy, regardless of number of years since being adopted BTRE reserves the right to regain possession of the named horse, even if Adopter re-homes horse or sells horse to third party. Any individual or organization in possession of the equine as of the date of the agreement and any time thereafter is bound tto not sell the equine at auction for slaughter or allow the equine to be sold, transferred, released, or otherwise placed into possession of any person or organization that will cause or allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter. In the event of Violation of this agreement. If adopter fails to comply with any term of this agreement, adopter agrees to pay BTRE \$1500.00 plus all attorney fees and all costs of legal action, including litigation that BTRE may incur to enforce the terms of this agreement. Adopter acknowledges that the additional \$1500.00 and cost are reasonable and fair.
