- 2. "ADOPTER" acknowledges that once the horse leaves HorseSense's property, HorseSense will not be responsible for any injury or loss of horse.
- 3. "ADOPTER" warrants that he/she owns the horse subject to this agreement and is responsible for all of the horse's care.
- 4. This agreement shall remain in effect until the death of the equine. The terms of the agreement are binding on any future adopter or any third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine. Any future adopter or any third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine must re-sign an agreement with the organization prior to the equine being placed into the possession of any future adopter or any third-party person or entity.
- 5. This agreement shall be binding on the parties, their successors, personal representatives and assigns. This agreement may not be assigned without the prior consent of the other party.
- 6. This agreement states that should the adopter decide to re-home the equine, our organization has first right of refusal or must grant approval of any individual or organization

intending to take possession of the equine for any reason prior to the equine being placed into the possession of such individual or organization, including being provided written notification of the name, address, and telephone number of any individual or organization intending to take possession of the equine for any reason.

- 7. This agreement states that our organization reserves the right to make scheduled visits.
- 8. Any individual or organization in possession of the equine as of the date of the agreement and any time thereafter is bound to not sell the equine at auction for slaughter or allow the equine to be sold, transferred, released, or otherwise placed into possession of any person or organization that will cause or allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter.
- 9. This agreement states that rehomed equines cannot be bred for any reason.
