

Mutual Adoption Agreement

<u>Home</u> > Mutual Adoption Agreement

Any individual or organization in possession of the equine as of the date of the agreement and any time thereafter is bound to not sell the equine at auction for slaughter or allow the equine to be sold, transferred, released, or otherwise placed into possession of any person or organization that will cause or allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter.

This agreement shall remain in effect until the death of the equine. The terms of the agreement are binding on any future adopter or third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine. Any future adopter or third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine must re-sign a Mutual Adoption Agreement with ReplayPolo prior the equine being placed into the possession of any future adopter or third-party person or entity. ALL adopters are bound to NEVER sell the equine at auction for slaughter or allow the equine to be sold, transferred, released, or otherwise placed into possession of any person or organization that will cause or allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter.

Should the adopter decide to re-home the equine, ReplayPolo must grant approval of any individual or organization intending to take possession of the equine for any reason prior to the equine being placed into the possession of such individual or organization, including being provided written notification of the name, address, and telephone number of any individual or organization intending to take possession of the equine for any reason. This agreement shall remain in effect until the death of the equine. The terms of the agreement are binding on any future adopter or any third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine. Any future agreement must require any future adopter or any third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine to re-sign an agreement with the organization prior to the equine being placed into the possession of any future adopter or any third-party person or entity.


